## 2. Non-Conformities Reported

1. Pesticide drums found without secondary containment; labels faded.
2. Sown seed variety not recorded in field logbook.
3. Rice threshers and sickles were not cleaned before harvest.
4. Missing dosage details for urea application in May batch.

## 3. Corrective Actions Taken

1. Containment trays installed; all pesticide labels replaced.
2. Seed variety details updated in the field logbook.
3. Harvest tools cleaned; SOP displayed in tool shed.
4. Urea dosage data retrieved and recorded from supplier documents.

## 4. Corrective Action Approved and Closed

All corrective actions have been verified and approved. Non-conformities are now closed:

1. Chemical Storage - Improve label verification frequency and documentation.
2. Hygiene Facilities - Establish routine restocking responsibility with daily checks.

One opportunity for improvement remains: hygiene station near worker rest area.
